

Concert Information

1) Make-Up and Supplies (See supply list given out before spring break))

Girls:

Hair: Dress Rehearsal and Concert—Performance Buns (bobby pins, hairnets, hair gel), check with the choreographer if another hair style is required

Makeup (For concert only - Sunday - May 3rd) Brown eye shadow—dark brown for fair skin, light brown for dark skin, Pink blush, Red lipstick - true red or ruby red, make up removal pads (optional) and a small mirror

Large t-shirt: For changing costumes

Boys:

Hair: Dress Rehearsal and concert - Long hair should be pulled off face

Makeup (For concert only Sunday - May 3rd) Brownish Red lipstick, Brownish red blush, make -up removal pads (optional) and small mirror

*Dancers may want to bring a pillow, beach towel or blanket to sit on in the gym (girls) or in chorus room (boys).

2) Costume bags - Dress Rehearsal and Concert

Dancers will need to bring a regular size grocery bag to ODC starting Friday, April 27– May 1st. Costumes will be distributed during this week.

Dancers need to bring their costume bag with their costumes inside to the theater both days. Dancers are not to wear their costumes to the theater on either day. (Middle School Students - DO NOT LEAVE YOUR COSTUMES IN YOUR LOCKER OR ON THE BUS) A "costume care" form will be coming home soon. Dancers will leave their costumes in their "team" costume hamper at the end of the 5:00 show. NO costumes or costume parts are allowed to go home after the last performance.

3) Dress Rehearsal (mandatory) - Saturday, May 2nd at Plaza Middle School - 2:00-6:00 (Parent volunteers arrive at 1:30)

Students are to eat before arriving. NO food or drinks (except PLAIN water) are allowed in the school building. Dancers are to report promptly at 2:00 pm to the auditorium with performance hair and with costume bag. No makeup today. Parents may leave during the rehearsal, but must return to the auditorium promptly by 6:00 for student dismissal. Students are to take their costumes home with them in their bags and bring the bags back for the concert.

Assigned Parent Volunteers are to meet with Mrs. Spear-Jones in the gym at 1:30 to review dressing room guidelines. Other parents are **not** allowed backstage /dressing room. Dancers are in very capable hands,

4) Dance Concert Sunday, May 3rd at Plaza Middle School at 2:00 (middle school parents) and 5:00 PM (elementary school parents) Parent volunteers for the 2:00 performance need to arrive at 12:45 and parent volunteers for the 5:00 show need to come back to the check in table after the 2:00 show)

Dancers report directly to dressing room promptly at 1:00. Only parent and teacher volunteers are allowed backstage. Please, no other parents backstage or in the dressing rooms. Dancers need to arrive with performance hair, makeup (apply lipstick in dressing room), costume bag and brown bag dinner. There is no admission charge. Audience members are not permitted to stand or sit in the aisles.

5) Student Entertainment

Students may bring personal items such as board games, books homework, iPods, CD players with earplugs, personal size gameboys with earplugs, etc. No Pic-o-Chat or other texting electronic equipment. **THE ODC DANCE EDUCATION PROGRAM IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR STOLEN ITEMS.** Please label all items with first and last name. Students are not allowed to use cell phones during dress rehearsal or during the concert.

6) Photography/Videotaping

Photography, videotaping or cell phones are **not** permitted during the concert. A professional videotape/DVD will be available for purchase from Video Horizons. Order forms and information will be located in the lobby. If you wish to take photographs (no flash - this is disruptive and sometimes can be blinding to the dancer) or video tape, you may do so during dress rehearsal. Please no tripods.
